You are aware that the Comptroller and Auditor General of India has conducted an All India Performance Audit Report on Total Sanitation campaign(TSC)/Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan (NBA) for the period from 2009-10 to 2013-14. The Draft Audit Report of this Audit has been submitted to this Ministry, seeking comments on the observations made therein.

2. Since TSC/NBA was implemented by states , it is imperative to obtain comments of state government, before responding to Audit's observations. A copy of the Performance Audit Report was therefore sent to the State governments vide this Ministry's letter no. D.O. No. G-11012/4/2015-SBM dated 20.3.2015 and addressed to Principal Secretaries/Secretary audit also through an email dated 20th March 2015 for furnishing comments on the audit paras concerned with your state. However despite follow-up by this Ministry, no reply has been received from your State in this regard, so far.
3. You will agree that response to performance Audit has to be provided in a time bound manner. Due to non- availability of information from the states, we have already sought one extension for response.
4. I will be grateful if you can issue appropriate instructions to the concerned officers/officials of your Department and ensure that comments of your State are sent this Ministry by 10th May 2015 positively.
5. You are therefore requested to issue appropriate instructions to the concerned officers/ officials of your Department for furnishing the comments to this Ministry by 10th May 2015 positively.
