It has been observed that there have been slippages of fully covered habitations to partially covered status due to various reasons like over-exploitation of ground water without adequate recharge leading to drying up of reduced yields, increase in population, setting up of new habitations, contamination of drinking water sources due to leaching of fertilizers, sewage and industrial effluents into ground water, etc.

In the 11th Plan, the focus was on sustainability in water availability and quality, etc. Please indicate the achievements in this regard during each year of 11th Plan and

during the 2012-13 and 2013-14. Are there instances of fully covered habitations slipping back to partially covered status, after having taken sustainability measures? If so, please give details of
