Sub: Survey regarding Status of Defunct Water Supply Schemes.

It has come to the notice to this Ministry from various sources that many rural water supply schemes in the States are lying dysfunctional for years together. However, as reported by the States on the Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of this Ministry the figure of these defunct scheme is only 2.16 percent of the total number of schemes.

In view of the wide variation in figures, as being brought to the notice of this Ministry from different independent sources, it is requested that a proper spot assessment /survey of all defunct water supply schemes/systems may be carried out on an urgent basis in your state and the correct status of the defunct/ non functional schemes be marked in the IMIS. The work may be taken up on priority and completed within 15 days and a report submitted to this Ministry.
