

**Minutes of the Meeting to discuss the NRDWP  
Annual Action Plan 2015-16 of Nagaland State**

1 An Annual Action Plan meeting with the representatives of Nagaland Government was held in the Conference Hall, 4th Floor, Paryavaran Bhawan, New Delhi on 10.02.2015 under the chairmanship of Joint Secretary (Water), Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The list of participants is given in Annexure.

**2 NRDWP**

- i. Rs. 52.15 Cr. is the total allocation for the year 2014-15.
- ii. JS (Water) reviewed the targets and achievements of the State for the year 2014-15 during the AAP meeting which is as follows. State was advised to prepare their plan after the final allocation of fund.

Last year State was requested to take up habitations with water coverage of 0 to 25% and 25 to 50% on priority basis, and it has been observed that the physical progress of NRDWP has been satisfactory as against the target during the Year 2014-15.

**3 The gist of the discussion is as follows**

- i. JS (Water) expressed displeasure over non-release of 1<sup>st</sup> instalment of Rs. 6 crore, held up by the State Finance Department and requested Secretary, PHED to expedite release of funds.

- ii. In the presentation, State has shown pictures of Steel Water Tanks, which is costlier than the traditional tanks. But considering Nagaland is a hilly terrain, it seems justified. However, JS (Water) suggested to construct such Steel Water Tanks on a case to case basis and also requested Technical Adviser for his advice on this matter.
- iii. JS (Water) said that State should provide safe drinking water to all quality affected habitation.
- iv. State officials were requested to submit their proposal for Support and WQMS funds. JS (Water) advised that State may utilize these funds during emergency for procuring Mobile Water Treatment Plant, Mobile Water Quality Testing Lab.
- v. The state should update IMIS data regularly and promptly so as to facilitate, proper monitoring and release of fund under various components.

**4** Once the exact allocation is communicated to the States, they can prepare the final AAP document and send 3 copies to the Ministry for approval in March, 2015.

The meeting ended with a Vote of Thanks to the chair.
