Subject: Regarding 'Elimination of Manual Scavenging'.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to the above mentioned subject and to say that the matter of implementation of 'Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013 is being reviewed at the highest and directions have been given to complete the Survey of Insanitary Latrines and simultaneously their conversion in time bound manner.

- 2. As per Para 5.4.6 of SBM (G) guidelines), incentive for the targeted beneficiaries is available while converting 'insanitary latrines' to 'sanitary latrines'. In respect of beneficiaries not entitled for incentive under SBM (G), funds disbursed to PRIs under the 14th Finance Commission may be utilized for converting 'insanitary latrines' to 'sanitary latrines'.
- 3. It is requested that concerned authorities in the Districts, responsible for implementation of SBM (G) programme may be directed that the Survey of Insanitary latrines should be completed by 31.12.2016 and all insanitary latrines found during the survey should be converted into sanitary latrines by 2.10.2017. State-wise Status of Survey and conversion of insanitary latrines to Sanitary Latrines is Annexed.
