- a. Keeping in view the reduced allocation of funds for the said scheme from MNRE for the 2016-17, the targets assigned to all States vide this office letter dated 14.10.2014 are being revised and attached at Annexure. States may consider these targets for immediate implementation of Scheme.
- b. It has been informed by the State representatives present in the said meeting that the estimated cost of the Solar panel (Rs. 1.8 Lakh) has further come down and States are gettinglower rates in the tendering. Hence, all States are requested to take the same into account in tendering.

A further review of the progress of said scheme will be taken in October, 2016. All States are requested to expedite the coverage of said scheme. Depending on progress made against the targets, a decision will be made at that time regarding diversion of targets to better performing States.
