Sub: **Implementation of NRDWP: Release of funds**

Madam / Sir,

Kindly refer to this Ministry DO letter of even number dated 24th August, 2016 (**copy enclosed**) wherein it was requested to expedite the completion of the schemes which are in advanced stage to provide water supply quickly to the targeted population. Moreover, it was also requested to utilize the funds released by this Ministry in this year along with matching share of State mandatorily for the schemes which are in the completion stage of 75% or more. If the States does not have such schemes, States may incur the expenditure on schemes which are in the stage of completion of 50% to 75% and in that order. While doing so, the States are requested to prioritize the schemes which are intended to cover Arsenic / Fluoride affected habitations, SAGY habitations, ODF (verified) habitations.

2. As requested vide the said letter and discussed in the National Level Review meeting held on 09.09.2016, States are required to give an undertaking along with their proposal for 2nd instalment for Programme Component, DDP Component and for both instalments of 5% W.Q Earmarked fund under NRDWP as per the format **enclosed**.

3. States are requested to send immediately the proposal for release of various component of NRDWP along with the above undertaking so as to enable this Ministry to take further action.

for Utilisation of fund in Ongoing Schemes which are in advanced stage of completion

1. The State is hereby submits undertaking that the funds released henceforth by MDWS under Programme Component, DDP Component, 5% WQ Earmarked Component of NRDWP fund would be utilized only for completion of ongoing schemes which are in advanced stage of completion **in following orders:**
 - (a) Schemes which are physically completed but financially not complete and schemes which is 75% or more completed.
 - (b) Schemes which are 50% to 75% physically completed.
 - (c) Schemes which are 25% to 50% physically completed.

2. While doing so, State would prioritize the schemes which are intended to cover Arsenic / Fluoride affected habitations, SAGY habitations, ODF (verified) habitations.
