During the meeting, the Finance Secretary has taken a serious view on huge unspent balance lying with the States under NRDWP. As a result of huge unspent balance, the Ministry of Finance will constraint to provide supplementary grants and increase the allocation under NRDWP. Secretary, MDWS has also expressed his displeasure with the pace of expenditure and updation of the same on the IMIS by the States.

- 2. In view of the above, it is requested to expedite the pace of the expenditure and update the same simultaneously in IMIS so that the unspent balance can be reduced to that extent so as to enable this Ministry to get more funds from Ministry of Finance.
- 3. This may be given utmost priority.
