Sub: Regarding survey for identification of insanitary latrines and their conversion to Sanitary latrines.


Sir/Madam,

Kindly refer to my letter of even no. dated 4.6.2014 available in the Ministry's website, regarding completion of survey of insanitary latrines and their conversion into sanitary latrines, and the need to coordinate with the "local authority" responsible for implementation of the "Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013", so as to obtain the list of insanitary latrines found by 'Local Authorities' and to convert such insanitary latrines into sanitary latrines using NBA, now SBM (G), resources.

2. A meeting of Committee of Secretaries (COS) was held on 9.12.2014 under the chairmanship of Secretary (Coordination), Cabinet Secretariat, Government of India to work out a Plan of Action for the 'elimination of manual scavenging' in a time bound manner in accordance with the directions of the Prime Minister. It was decided in the meeting that Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation will expedite action for identification of all insanitary latrines in rural areas and their conversion into sanitary latrines.

3. The number of insanitary latrines found and converted as per data furnished by your state through IMIS in pursuance of this Ministry's instructions is given in Annexure-I. It is requested that districts may be directed to complete the survey for identification of insanitary latrines and their conversion into sanitary latrines using SBM(G) resources in all eligible cases urgently, as "Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013" has already come into force. The information on the IMIS may be updated.
