The States are required to prepare Annual Implementation Plans (AIPs) each year. The Plan reflects the annual activities that are to be undertaken to achieve the overall goal of Swachh Bharat on/or before 2nd October 2019.

- 2. The Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) reflects reorientation of the rural sanitation programme towards achievement of outcomes on a sustainable basis. Under the new programme, the key element is behaviour change. There is also a focus on achievement of open defecation free villages and their sustainability. Community-led processes have been mentioned as a preferred approach since that ensures sustainability of outcomes. The capacity building towards community approach has, therefore, been emphasized and a number of initiatives are being taken towards that end. There is also an attempt to improve the overall capacities for programme implementation, including simplifying the administrative and financial mechanisms, improving transparency and reorienting efforts towards achievement of results. Evaluation and documentation is also being emphasized. The States are expected to use the flexibility given to them to promote innovations.
- 3. Keeping in view the above, the AIP2017-18 format has been revised and is attached herewith. State Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) 2017-18 as per the template may please be sent in hard copy and also uploaded on Ministry Website/SBM(G)-MIS on or before 10.2.2017. The AIP-2017-18 meeting will be held on 18th February, 2017 at National Institute of Rural Development (NIRD), Hyderabad along with Conference of State Secretaries on 17th-18th Feb, 2017.
