





The Ministry has initiated two days orientation training on Swachh Bharat Mission for the said officials on a regular basis so that all such officials working at the district level are covered in a short span of time. The objective of the orientation training is to expose officials to the details of the programme and best practices and to motivate them for the leadership role that they have to play for the country to achieve the goals of Swachh Bharat Mission by 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2019.

3. The first eight such trainings were held from February to June 2015, and were attended by 206 participants at the level of DMs/DCs etc. We are getting encouraging reports for the districts from where the officials attended these trainings.
