Subject: Implementation of Bulk Water Supply (BWS) schemes under NRDWP


Madam / Sir,

Kindly refer to this Ministry letter dated 13.05.2016 vide which allocation under various components of NRDWP had been intimated.

2. In consonance with the policy of this Ministry with regard to gradual shift from the groundwater sources to surface water sources, it has been decided that from the current financial year, each State shall take up at least one BWS scheme based on surface water sources. The Scheme so taken would be among the ongoing surface water based scheme. And to speed up the progress of such BWS scheme for its completion, it has been decided by the competent authority of this Ministry to earmark part of Programme Fund (Central share) of the allocation made vide above said letter. The fund being earmarked for BWS scheme(state-wise) is enclosed.
3. The State is required to furnish the details of such schemes as per format (Enclosed herewith) by 30.07.2016 to this Ministry at email: **sriva.1966@gmail.com** in ms-excel so that the expenditure made for such BWS scheme can be captured in IMIS for monitoring.
4. No separate funding for taking up such schemes would be made available to the States.
5. The States, where currently there is no such ongoing BWS scheme, would be allowed to take up one new scheme of such nature.
