Madam,

The communication cited above is very relevant to ensure that safe and hygienic structures are created to have a sustained ODF. To address this issue, Rajasthan State has taken the following steps, which are being communicated widely at all levels.

The State has taken an initiative to ensure that every PRI member has a sustainable toilet and that every member of his or her family uses the toilet. Based on the basic prerequisites of para 5.4 of SBM (G) guidelines, the State has defined the toilet as follows: "Sanitary toilet means a water sealed toilet system or set up surrounded by 3 walls, a door and a roof" to ensure access to sustainable toilets. Accordingly, an ordinance has been issued on December 8, 2014. A copy of the same in Hindi and its authorised translation in English is enclosed.

Also the department has issued an order to all the districts, which clearly state that the toilets should have a safe substructure and proper super structure with hand washing facility of value not less than Rs.12,000/-. Also directions have been given that effluents from the toilets shall not be disposed in the open or open drains.

Therefore, the State has adequately addressed the concern of Government of India.
