Sustainable Drinking Water and Sanitation for all in Rural Areas

National Consultation with State Ministers and Secretaries in charge of Rural Sanitation on 20-21st December, 2012 at Scope Complex, New Delhi

National Consultation with State Ministers and Secretaries in charge of Rural Sanitation is scheduled to be held on 20-21st December, 2012 at New Delhi.

Rural sanitation came into focus in the Government of India in the World Water Decade of 1980s. The Central Rural Sanitation Programme (CRSP)was started in 1986 to provide sanitation facilities in rural areas. It was simply a supply driven, highly subsidy and infrastructure oriented programme. As a result of deficiencies and low financial allocations, the CRSP had very little impact on the gargantuan problem. The experience of community –driven, awareness-generating campaign based programme in some states and the results of evaluation of CRSP, led to the formulation of Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC) approach in 1999.

In 2012,the TSC has been revamped as Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan (NBA), which has been launched with modified guidelines and objectives to further accelerate sanitation coverage in the rural areas so as to comprehensively cover the rural community with renewed strategies. NBA has brought major changes in the rural sanitation programme by widening the provision of incentive for individual household latrine units to cover identified Above Poverty Line (APL) households who belong to Scheduled Castes (SC) /Scheduled Tribes (ST), small and marginal farmers, landless labourers with homesteads, physically challenged and women headed households alongwith all Below Poverty Line (BPL) households .Under NBA, incentive has been increased to Rs 4600 (Rs 3200 from Centre + Rs 1400 from State) + (Rs 500 extra for hilly and difficult areas from Centre). Additional financial assistance upto Rs 4500/- per IHHL has been provided in convergence with Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) for all eligible beneficiaries .

Through visits, feedback and review meetings, it is learnt that the implementation of NBA in convergence with MNREGS has not been fully streamlined as yet and States are facing some difficulties in operationalizing the convergence.

The main objectives of the National Consultation meeting would be to provide a forum for the participation of the political leadership at State level, State Secretaries, District and field functionaries, NGOs and international resource agencies to discuss various issues linked with implementation of NBA and to identify changes, modification for up-scaling the Nirmal Bharat for making India a Nirmal Bharat.
