Sir,

As you are aware, Total Sanitation Campaign is a community driven, awareness generation, campaign based programme which is implemented in a project mode. The TSC on-line monitoring system helps in monitoring and decision-making based on Management Information reports, generated from data uploaded by the field functionaries.

The Chief Information Commissioner has in a letter drawn attention to the high level of transparency in NREGS reports. For instance detailed information on every job card holder, works done by him, payment made to him, muster rolls, etc are all available online in the public domain. He has recommended that other Centrally sponsored schemes also provide more information on expenditures, in the public domain in the interest of transparency and accountability.

In the light of this, it is proposed to include following details to be filled up in the on-line monitoring system in addition to the existing details:

- 1) In respect of BPL beneficiaries, while updating status of Gram Panchayat, names of BPL beneficiary with BPL card number is to be filled up in sub-menu to arrive at the total number of toilets constructed for the BPL households. Data entry may start with the toilets constructed in 2009-10 followed by those constructed in 2008-09 and so on for earlier years.
- 2) Address/Location of all school toilets. Anganwadi toilets and community sanitary complexes to be filled up in the sub-menu as per the format to arrive at the achievement in respective GPs.
- 3) Photograph of one school toilet built under TSC from each Gram Panchayat. Where community sanitary complexes have been constructed, a photograph of that may also be uploaded.
- 4) We are also making arrangements to ensure that uploading of photographs does not affect the speed of the online system.

As the updation of GP status is mandatory for completing the project objective to become eligible for NGP, these details would be required for next year's NGP applications. The tentative date for updation of GP status will be from 16th August 2009 onwards.

You are requested to kindly issue necessary directions to all concerned accordingly.
