प्रिय आलोक,

अतः मैं अनुरोध करता हूँ कि गंगा नदी के दोनों किनारों पर रह रहे सभी गाँवों में वैयक्तिक पारिवारिक शौचालयों साथ ही साथ सामुदायिक शौचालय परिसरों की सुविधा उपलब्ध कराएँ, ताकि नदी का पानी स्वच्छ और प्रदूषण रहित रहे और इसका उपयोग पेयजल स्कीम के लिए अच्छे स्रोत के रूप में किया जा सके।

इस संबंध में आपके राज्य द्वारा उठाए गए कदमों के बारे में 10-15 दिनों के भीतर सूचना दें। गंगा के दोनों किनारों पर संस्वीकृत वैयक्तिक और सामुदायिक शौचालय और गाँवों की संख्या के बारे में प्रत्येक माह संस्वीकृत/निर्मित गाँवों के नाम बताते हुए 1 और 16वीं तिथि को इस मंत्रालय को बताएँ।
