During a recently held review meeting, Rajasthan State proposed that NGOs may also be allowed as Implementing Agencies for implementation of Individual House Hold Latrine (IHHL) under MGNREGS in convergence with NBA.

- 2. As per Para 2. (g) of MGNREG Act, "implementing agency" includes any department of Central Government or a State Government, a Zila Parishad, Panchayat at intermediate level, Gram Panchayat or any local authority or Government under taking or non-governmental organisation authorised by the Central Government or the State Government to undertake the implementation of any work taken up under a Scheme.
- 3. To facilitate implementation of NBA in convergence with MGNREGS, it is proposed to amend the guidelines issued on this subject. The draft amendment is enclosed for your concurrence.

CIRCULAR

Subject: Permitting reputed NGOs to undertake implementation of IHHL under MGNREGA.

Based on feedbackreceived and in concurrence with Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Ministry of Rural Development have carried out amendment in Para 6.3 a) and b) of the guidelines, dated 11th September, 2012, to enable reputed NGOs to undertake implementation of IHHL under MGNREGA.

The existing Para 6.3 a) i.e. "The GP concerned will be the Implementing Agency" is replaced by

"The GP concerned will normally be the Implementing Agency. Reputed nongovernmental organisations having a proven track record and authorised by the Central Government or the State Government can also be allowed to undertake the implementation of IHHL. However, if any NGO undertakes the implementation of IHHL, the original muster rolls, measurement books and expenditure details etc. will be deposited in the concerned GP after completion of work and GP will maintain the record. Concerned GP will also be responsible for the data entry in respect of such muster, works and other required details."

The existing Para 6.3 b) i.e. "On receipt of a request from the GP the PO will issue muster rolls" is replaced by

"On receipt of a request from the GP, the PO will issue required muster rolls. In case the works are being executed through NGOs, NGOs will request the GP to have the muster issue, from the PO. On receipt of such a request, the concerned GP will had got get the muster roll issued from the PO and pass them on to the concerned NGO for further action. "
