Sir/ Madam,

You might be aware that Swachh Bharat Mission was launched on 2nd October, 2014 by the Honourable Prime Minister, to achieve the vision of “Swachh Bharat” by 2nd October 2019, the 150th Birthday of Mahatma Gandhi, Father of the Nation.

2. Implementation of Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) has been assigned to the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation.
3. The Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation provides financial and technical assistance to the States to help in achieving the vision of Swachh Bharat. With the launch of Swachh Bharat Mission on 2nd October 2014, India has embarked upon a journey of cleanliness transformation in rural landscape. As 2nd October, 2019 is the target date for making entire country open defecation free (ODF), the Ministry has taken all necessary steps to achieve this goal. However, this is possible only if all the stakeholders are coming together to make the entire country open defecation free and clean. This requires immense behaviour change on our part.
4. Many States and districts are marching ahead towards the goal of Swachh Bharat since the launch of SBM(G). Some of the districts in your State are also doing very well in implementing the scheme. However, some of the districts are yet to peak up the momentum.
5. To understand the constraints of districts in reaching the last mile, and for districts to bring out issues such as funding, capacities, resources etc. in achieving ODF, the Ministry of

Drinking Water and Sanitation is sending officers to facilitate the process for attaining ODF in your State.

6. During the visit to your state, the visiting officer will discuss those issues pertaining to allotted district(s) with the concerned district officials (copy of list of the districts allotted to the concerned officer is attached). Exact tour programmes will be communicated by the concerned officer before his /her visit.

7. He/ she would also like to have discussion about implementation of the Scheme in your State at your convenience.
