Kindly refer to this Ministry's letters No. W-11013/5/1999/CRSP dated 19.10.2012 and 5.12.2012 regarding conversion of **bucket latrines (dry latrines) into pour flush latrines (sanitary latrines)** to address the problem of manual scavenging and to formulate a time bound action plan. The information regarding number and names of villages having night soil removed by humans as per information received from Registrar General of India has already been provided to your State. A CD containing the information is again enclosed for your ready reference. The Central Monitoring Committee (CMC) under the Chairmanship of Cabinet Secretary is continuously monitoring the progress for eradication of practice of manual scavenging. It has been decided that action for conversion of dry latrines into sanitary latrines may be expedited in a time bound manner.

Census of India has also reported the existence of 12.76 lakh households with insanitary latrines in rural areas of the country. These include 3.72 lakh household having latrines in which night soil is disposed into open drain and 3.18 lakh households in which the latrines are serviced by animals beside 5.86 lakh households in which the latrines are serviced by human beings (dry latrines). The state-wise details are at Annexure-I. The district-wise details of insanitary latrines in respect of your State are at Annexure-II.

It is requested that all insanitary latrines including the dry latrines should be converted by using NBA resources in case of all households that are found to be eligible under NBA guidelines irrespective of whether or not such households fall within the Gram Panchayats chosen on saturation basis for conversion into Nirmal Gram Panchayat during any year.

The progress of the conversion of these insanitary latrines will be monitored online through the Monthly Progress Report for which

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suitable changes have been made for facilitating the online data entry by the States / Districts. Linkage for data entry is available on data entry section of Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan's website i.e. www.tsc.gov.nic.

I request you to look into the matter personally and direct all concerned officers in the State / Districts so that the aim of eradication of the practice of manual scavenging could be achieved without any delay.
