Subject: Monthly summary for the month of November, 2020 in respect of Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation.

Progress in Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)

During the month of November, 2020, about 16.80 lakh households have been provided tap water connections. So far 1.87 crore households have been provided the tapwater connections in year 2020-21. An amount of Rs.872.55 crore has been released to States/UTs under the programme during the month.

Progress in Swachh Bharat Mission- Grameen Phase-II

During the month of November, 2020, 31,805 Individual household toilets under Left-out from Baseline Survey (LOB) and 1,85,323 Individual household toilets under No one Left Behind (NOLB) have been constructed. Also 9,055 Community Sanitary Complexes have been constructed during the month. Under Garib Kalyan Rozgar Abhiyan (GKRA), 29,695 Community Sanitary Complexes (CSCs) have been constructed so far. Also 20,436 CSCs are under progress. An amount of Rs.200.50 crore has been released to States/UTs under the programme during the month.

Monitoring of JJM

Mid-year review of Mizoram was held on 01.11.2020 through VC to review the progress under Jal Jeevan Mission.

Virtual Conference of State Ministers for Rural Water Supply was held on 03.11.2020 to review the progress under the Mission.

World Toilet Day 2020

Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation (DDWS) observed World Toilet Day 2020 with a Sarpanch Samvad — a virtual dialogue with Sarpanchs of ODF Plus villages; and a Puruskar Samaroh — distribution of awards to top 20 districts for overall performance in SBM-G. The event was held in New Delhi on November 19, 2020. In his address, Union Minister Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat highlighted that the SBMG has transformed rural India by manifesting into a Jan Andolan for sanitation under the guidance and leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, achieving Open Defecation Free (ODF) rural India milestone in mission mode, in a span of five years.

Mid-Term review meeting with ACS/Principal Secretary/Secretary and Mission Directors in-charge of Rural Sanitation in States of Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, Manipur, Assam, Odisha, Mizoram, Jharkhand, Maharashtra, West Bengal, Sikkim, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Tripura, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana, Chhattisgarh and Bihar was organized from 05.11.2020 to 27.11.2020 at CGO Complex, New Delhi.
