Sir/Madam,

We would like to acknowledge your assistance towards the success of Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) in improving the sanitation coverage in your State. As we move towards our target of achieving 100 districts and 150,000 villages ODF by March 2017, it becomes essential that this information is correctly reflected in IMIS maintained by Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation.

2. We have been informed from several States that some villages declared as ODF are not being reflected in IMIS because there is no single household entry for that particular village. Hence, I request you to work with your State Coordinators and State MIS coordinators to ensure the following:-

- Deletion of duplicate data in IMIS (No. of duplicate entries attached as Annexure).
- Villages, blocks and districts declared as ODF are correctly reflected in IMIS
- Before declaring a village ODF, all the households should have toilet or access to toilet in IMIS. This can be done using entry mode in C06 and C07 and Data on Management Menu.
