

SUCCESS STORY

Raised Platform constructed at Badadangua (Karua sahi) of G.B.Nagar Block serving the need of drinking water during flood.

Flood is a recurring phenomena in Udala Sub-Division. The tubewells are submerged during flood period in the flood prone areas of Badasahi, G.B.Nagar and Khunta Block as a result of which people are deprived of getting safe drinking water.

To mitigate this problem, raised platform has been constructed in villages of flood prone areas. One such platform has been constructed at village Badadangua (Karuasahi), GP- Sanakhunta of G.B. Nagar block (Shown in picture). Now,

people are able to collect water from the tubewell during flood as well as post flood period. Smt Saudamini Parida a house wife of Badadangua village stated "We are happy that due to construction of raised platform, we are able to get drinking water during the flood".



The dugwell source at village - B.C. Pur (Hikim sahi) GP-B.C. Pur Block-Khunta has been developed and one IM - II has been fitted on a RCC cover slab for easy lifting of drinking water. The platform around the well has also been constructed for easy approach and cleanness. One beneficiary Smt. Laxmi Hansda who was collecting water through hand pump told that they are very happy after development of source as well as the water is now free from contamination. Previously we were not getting pure water for drinking purpose as it was opened.
