प्रिय महोदय/महोदया,

जैसा कि आप जानते हैं, पेयजल एवं स्वच्छता मंत्रालय ने देश भर में बहुत से मुख्य संसाधन केन्द्र (केआरसी) नियुक्त किए हैं। केआरसी के मुख्य उद्देश्य हैं:-

- पीएचईडी इंजीनियरों, पीआरआई प्रतिनिधियों, मास्टर ट्रेनरों और अन्य स्टेकहोल्डरों के ज्ञान, कौशल और दृष्टिकोणों का उन्नयन करना।
- प्रभावशाली और सतत तरीके से सौंपे गए उत्तरदायित्वों को करने के लिए प्रशिक्षुओं को बौद्धिक और व्यावसायिक तौर पर सक्षम बनाना।
- नई प्रौद्योगिकियों और अभिनव प्रयोगों पर व्यक्तिगत अप टू डेट रखना और व्यक्तियों और संगठनों के बेहतर कार्य निष्पादन हेतु व्यावसायिक ज्ञान और जरूरी कौशल को बढ़ाना।
- प्रशिक्षुओं को व्यावसायिक बुद्धिमत्ता प्राप्त करने में प्रेरित करना और योग्य बनाना।
- बढ़ते मुद्दों और चुनौतियों की तर्ज पर व्यवहारगत रिओरिएंटेशन को बढ़ावा देना, ग्रामीण समुदाय के मुद्दों और चिंताओं पर ध्यान केन्द्रित करना और उन्हें पेयजल सुविधाओं की योजना बनाने, कार्यान्वयन और मॉनीटरिंग की प्रक्रिया में शामिल करना।

- व्यावसायिक आवश्यकताओं को बेहतर समझ को बढ़ावा देना, साथ ही सामाजिक, आर्थिक, प्रौद्योगिकीय और राजनैतिक वातावरण के प्रति संवेदी बनाना जिसमें कार्यान्वयन किया जाना है।
- केन्द्र और राज्य स्तर पर अन्य संबंधित कार्यक्रमों के साथ तालमेल बिठाने के बारे में ज्ञान और कौशल बढ़ाना।
- संप्रेषण और क्षमता इकाई एकक की क्षमता विकसित करना।

2. अतः आपसे अनुरोध है कि राज्य, जिला, ब्लॉक और ग्राम पंचायत स्तर पर उपयुक्त प्रशिक्षुओं/स्टेकहोल्डरों की पहचान करें और संलग्न प्रशिक्षण कैलेंडर 2014-15 के अनुसार विभिन्न केआरसी द्वारा संचालित किए जाने वाले प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम में उन्हें नामित करें। नामांकन मंत्रालय की वैबसाइट पर अपलोड किया जा सकता है और प्रारंभ में ही संबंधित केआरसी को संप्रेषित किया जाता है। केआरसी को भेजे गए संप्रेषण की एक प्रति इस मंत्रालय को भी मार्क की जाए। नामांकन की प्रक्रिया को 25.6.2014 तक पूरा करने की जरूरत है।
