कृपया गंगा नदी के तट पर खुले में शौच को कम करने की आवश्यकता से संबंधित आपके राज्य के मुख्य सचिव को संबोधित दिनांक 13 जून, 2014 और 23 जून, 2014 का सचिव, एमडीडब्ल्यूएस, भारत सरकार के अ.शा. पत्र का संदर्भ लें। इसके साथ ही गंगा नदी के तट पर स्थित ग्राम पंचायतों में आईएचएचएल और सीएसी उपलब्ध कराने की विशेष मुहिम और एनबीए एमआईएस पर इन ग्राम पंचायतों के संबंध में आधारभूत आँकड़ों को प्रविष्ट करने संबंधी इस मंत्रालय के दिनांक 17.06.2014 के पत्र का संदर्भ भी कृपया लें।

इस मंत्रालय ने उपर्युक्त विषय पर अब एक मसौदा कार्ययोजना तैयार कर ली है जो इस पत्र के साथ संलग्न है, कृपया देखें।

कार्य योजना के भाग 'क' में उन कार्यों की सूची दी गई है जो कार्य योजना के प्रारंभिक चरण में किए जाएँगे। प्रत्येक ग्राम पंचायत के लिए आधारभूत आँकड़े उसके बाद एमआईएस पर उपलब्ध होंगे।

कार्य योजना के भाग 'ख' में वे आगामी कार्य दिए गए हैं जो प्रत्येक ग्राम पंचायत में स्वच्छता की स्थिति को बेहतर बनाने के लिए राज्यों द्वारा किए जाएँगे। इन ग्राम पंचायतों में स्वच्छता की सुविधाएँ उपलब्ध कराने के लिए निर्धारित अविध के लक्ष्य भी प्रस्तावित हैं। कार्य योजना को शीघ्र ही अंतिम रूप दिया जाएगा। उसे तीव्र करने के लिए राज्य सरकारों के साथ चर्चा आवश्यक है। इसी संदर्भ में, चार राज्यों के अधिकारियों के साथ दिनांक 8.7.2014, मंगलवार को पूर्वाहन 2 बजे से 3 बजे तक विडीयो कॉन्फ्रेंस निर्धारित की गई है।

यह अनुरोध है कि राज्य के एनबीए के प्रभारी विभागीय अधिकारी के साथ राज्य के एनबीए के प्रभारी सभी प्रधान सचिव/सचिव वीसी में भाग लें। वीसी के दौरान मसौदा कार्य योजना पर चर्चा की जाएगी और उसे अंतिम रूप दिया जाएगा।

अंतिम रूप के निर्धारण के पश्चात, कार्ययोजना को पीएमओ तथा जल संसाधन मंत्रालय से साझा किया जाएगा। कार्य योजना के कार्यान्वयन की निगरानी पाक्षिक रूप से की जाएगी। इसे विचारार्थ सबसे उच्च स्थान दिया जाए।

Action Plan

Rejuvenation and Development of River Ganga

- 1. For Rejuvenation and Development of River Ganga, Advisories have been issued to States regarding the fact that there should be no toilets and open defecation within 15 m of the high flood level of Ganga and its tributaries.
- 2. As regards the situation in areas adjoining the banks of the Ganga, it has been decided to set up a Monitoring System for the same based on the NBA-IMIS of this Ministry.
- 3. An Action Plan has been prepared and is as below. The Action Plan consists of 2 parts.
 - Part A comprises of the action to be taken in the preparatory stage of the Action Plan.
 - Part B of the Plan gives details of the future action to be taken to improve the sanitation situation in the identified GPs. Goals to be achieved, Indicators to be monitored and the Time frame to achieve the goals are also included in this part.

Action Plan - Part A

- I. All the Gram Panchayats (GPs) falling in both the banks of the River Ganga are to be identified, at the field level. *This work is nearing completion*.
- II. All the Gram Panchayats (GPs) thus identified are to be marked on the NBA MIS of the Ministry. Necessary provision for the same have been enabled on the IMIS (under Data management menu of the NBA MIS, accessible through the Sate and Districts login). This work is nearing completion.
- III. As of 28.6.2014, in the 4 riparian states of the Ganga i.e. Uttarakhand, UP, Bihar and West Bengal, 1496 GPs in 220 Blocks of 46 districts have been identified as being adjoining the River Ganga. Statewise details are at Annexure 1.
- IV. The Baseline data of Sanitation Coverage of each of these 1496 GPs (at GP level) has been extracted and is now available on the IMIS. The remaining number of HHs to be provided with IHHLs in each of these GPs is ascertained.

- V. Household level data for each of these GP is to be/being entered on the NBA-IMIS on priority by the States. It is proposed that the details of the Baseline data of these GP's be entered on the IMIS by 15 July 2014.
- VI. Monitoring of the monthly achievement in the coverage of each of the 1496 GPs in terms of the following parameters will be done on the following parameters. This has been started:
 - (a) Coverage of Uncovered HHs with IHHLs.
 - (b) Coverage of Schools with Toilets.
 - (c) Coverage of Anganwadis with Toilets.
 - (d) Building of CSCs in the GPs
 - (e) From August 2014, we shall start monitoring the SLWM works in these GPs.
- VII. Extract of the Consolidated Report of the Base line data and Coverage Progress
 Details are at Annexure II IV of the Action Plan.
