Madam / Sir,

- 1. This is to bring to your notice that the Ministry is reviewing the subject **four Issues** as per the directives of Ministry of Home Affairs and the Cabinet Secretariat. The references in this respect are as under:
 - a. <u>Installation of Solar Dual Pumps</u> (States as listed in <u>Appendix</u>): These Pumps are being installed under NCEF and also with the assistance of MNRE. To have firm information regarding the progress, the Ministry have written letters dated 04.07.17 & 10.07.17 (copy <u>enclosed</u>). The details in this regard may be furnished in the formats provided in these letters and in the format as per <u>Annexure-I</u> as well.
 - b. <u>Water Conservation</u> (All States): As directed by the Cabinet Secretariat, the Ministry is to feed the data to Ministry of Water Resources regarding Water Conservation measures. In this connection, format C-28 A (enclosed as <u>Annexure-II</u>) has been re-designed in IMIS to capture the data to be fed by the states. In this respect, our letter dated 11.07.17 is <u>enclosed</u>.
 - c. <u>Drinking Water Infrastructure in Border Outposts (BOP)</u> (States as listed in <u>Appendix</u>): To provide drinking water to sustain tough life conditions in BOP, the Ministry has asked the states through various letters (listed in the <u>Appendix</u>) to furnish their Plan in this respect. However, no response has yet been received.
 - d. <u>Disaster Management Plan</u> (All States): The Ministry had requested vide letter dated 02.12.2016 (copy <u>enclosed</u>) to prepare 'State Level Action Plans for Preparedness' in respect of rural drinking water and sanitation sectors against any untoward incident and furnish the same to MoDWS by 31.12.2016. In view of the above, it is requested to furnish the information asked in the <u>Annexure-III</u> of this letter.
- 2. To take a stock of situation and commitment from the states for their response, a Video Conference with them is being convened on 14.07.2017 and 17.07.2017 as per the schedule in the <u>Appendix</u>.

It is requested to ensure participation of the concerned Officers (of not below the rank of SE) who can apprise the situation and make the commitment on behalf of the states.
