School Sanitation and Hygiene Education (SSHE) is an important component of Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC). TSC has provision for providing school toilet units in all Government schools viz. Primary, Upper-Primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary. Funding for school sanitation in TSC Project is provided by the Central and the State Governments in the ratio of 70:30. The TSC Guidelines lay emphasis on toilets for girls in schools and that separate toilets for girls and boys should be provided in all co-education schools. Each such unit is treated as separate unit and is entitled to Central assistance.

The online monitoring system maintained by the Department has the provision of reporting the number of toilets for girls (exclusively). However, it is noted that the progress against the same has not been reported by the districts, while uploading Monthly Progress Report. As a result, correct information on number of toilet units provided for girls under TSC cannot be compiled.

It is, therefore, requested to issue directives to all concerned to upload the information in this regard and hereafter report the progress on a monthly basis, so that compiled information on the same may be generated online. This may be treated as urgent, so that the Report of July 2010 is uploaded with necessary information.
