Guidelines for Technical Paper:

1. The lead country will circulate an invitation for submission of summary of technical papers on 8 (eight) thematic Technical Focus Sessions through any convenient way (public call, news media, circular in organization's/institution's website, direct contact etc.) within a fixed timeline with a copy to SACOSAN-VI Secretariat. The papers from the participants of other than the lead country should be submitted to the respective country focal person who will then pass it to the lead country;

2. A general circular will also be floated in the SACOSAN-VI website with a list of thematic

Technical Focus Sessions with the name of lead countries;

3. The lead country will review all submitted papers and select four best write ups to prepare

presentation;

4. The lead country will ask the respective four selected individuals/organizations /institutes/civil societies to submit full papers not exceeding 12 pages and the presentations not exceeding 15 minutes. The lead country will review all selected papers and presentations and ask them to submit the final version if there is any correction;

5. The Country Focal Person of lead country will then forward the finalized four papers and presentations with detail address of the speaker to the SACOSAN-VI Secretariat for further

action:

6. No paper and presentation will be received after October 2015 by the SACOSAN-VI Secretariat.
