Subject: Change of functionality status of completed scheme and taking up of new scheme

Madam / Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry letter of even number dated 01.08.2018 regarding Yearly Data Updation (YDU) for 2018-19, it has been found imperative to take into account the following:

If State desires to change the status of functional schemes into non-functional, the State is required to mention the reason in IMIS and upload the request duly signed by Secretary, in-charge of Rural Water Supply in the State in IMIS.

While taking up new PWS Schemes in exceptional category or approved otherwise

- by the Ministry, a) The State cannot include habitations which are already fully covered (with 40 lpcd) with PWS in the first instance. In case, State still wants to include such habitations for any reason whatever, the proportionate funding on such habitations is to be kept out of calculation for NRDWP Central Share and the same would be borne solely by the State from its own resources.
- b) In a particular village, all non-FC habitations or non-PWS habitations in that village must be included in that PWS scheme. For any valid reason for not doing so, the State is required to mention the reason in IMIS and upload the request duly signed by Secretary, in-charge of Rural Water Supply in the State in IMIS.
- The State may also contact the concerned Area Officer for any difficulties / queries.
