**Tour Report of
Shri Junaid Ahmed Usmani, (Consultant-Monitoring and Evaluation) and
Shri Pramod Kumar, (Scientific-Officer, NIC)
Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation to Nilokheri, Haryana
on 18th April, 2012**

As per instruction of Joint Secretary(Sanitation), We, Junaid Ahmed Usmani, Consultant-M & E and Pramod Kumar, NIC visited Haryana Institute of Rural Development, Nilokheri Haryana on 18th April, 2012 to participate in the "State level Training programme on TSC project revision template and up-dation of beneficiaries' details on MDWS website".

2. The Training was organized by the Development & Panchayats Department, Government of Haryana. 42 Additional Deputy Commissioners cum Chief Executive Officers DRDAs/Data entry operators/Accountants have attended the training programme.

3. Shri Pramod Kumar, NIC made a presentation on Online Monitoring System in TSC. Total Sanitation Campaign is a comprehensive programme to ensure sanitation facilities in rural areas with broader goal to eradicate the practice of open defecation by 2017. TSC is running in all the 607 districts across the country. Paper based reporting is not accepted under TSC. States have to entered progress in TSC-MIS online software only. All the major decision are being taken by MDWS on the based of data received in TSC-MIS. Recently Ministry has started capturing SWACHCHHATADOOT Information, information regarding NGO involved, intimation to state Secretaries/coordinators through SMS regarding monthly progress (Physical & Financial) entry done by districts. Ministry has also started auto email services to state secretaries/nodal officers regarding submission of MRP etc.

4. He discussed various Data Entry Modules in details. There is issue of regular updation of Panchayats Directory. District should contact DIO, NIC for any updation in Panchayat Directory. Districts of Fatehabad, Jind, Rohtak and Yamuna Nagar have given loan but number of toilets constructed is not shown. These districts expedite the same. There is difference in achievement of IHHLs reported in District MPR and Panchayat MPR. As per District MPR, 20,19,501 individual household latrines reported to be constructed. Whereas as per Panchayat MPR this comes to 1560705.

Districts must ensure updation of Panchayat MPRs. Also as per Panchayat MPR, 498177 IHHLs have been provided to BPLs. But details are available for only 459491 households. **Districts must ensure updation of beneficiaries' details on priority basis.**

5. Representative from Sirsa raised the issue of change in targets and achievements in GP data entry. It was explained that district can increase the targets but sum of GP targets should not be more than District target. Representative from Fatehabad requested for correction in expenditure figures reported in Administration and IEC. In this regard it was clarified that district should send request through State Govt. to Director(CRSP), Ministry of Drinking water and Sanitation clearly mentioning the month-wise old reported figure and corrected figure. Panipat raised the issue of shifting of 2 GPs to Urban Area. Jhajhar raised the issue of duplicate Panchayat name. It was suggested that district should contact DIO, NIC for rectification in GPs. All the issues raised by districts were solved using live examples.

6. Junaid Ahmed Usmani made a presentation on revision of Project Implementation Plan(PIP). The various tables of revised PIP were explained in detailed. The IHHL without toilets at the baseline survey(census-2011) and toilets constructed under TSC between the date of sanction of TSC and date of BLS. For preparation of revised project district should utilize village-wise Census 2011 data. District raised the issue of shift of BPLs to APLs. In this regards it was explained that toilets constructed for BPLs should be shown in revised targets in revised PIP.

7. Some of the important issues were :-


- (i) The beneficiaries details of remaining BPLs will be entered on priority basis
- (ii) Regular updation of GP Directory in the MOPR
- (iii) Entering of Swachchhata doot information
- (iv) Entering of NGO details
- (v) Reporting of IHHL built from revolving funds
- (vi) Uploading of data of those GPs where water supply is there
- (vii) In case of correction/change in data , user can change but it should not be less than previously reported figures

- (viii) In case any change in old figures, write a request to Director(Sanitation)
- (ix) Regular uploading of expenditure of revolving funds, SLWM
- (x) Regular updation of district coordinators details
- (xi) Uploading district wise action plan for 2012-13
