MINUTES OF THE 45th NSSC MEETING HELD
ON 14th MARCH, 2012

The 45th National Scheme Sanctioning Committee (NSSC) meeting was held in the conference room of ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Paryawaran Bhawan, New Delhi under the chairpersonship of Smt. Vilasini Ramachandran, Secretary, Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Government of India on 14th March, 2012. The list of participants is given at **Annexure I**.

Secretary (DWS) welcomed all the members and officials present in the meeting. Thereafter the regular items on the Agenda were taken-up.

Agenda items:

1. The minutes of the 44th NSSC meeting held on 2nd June, 2010 were circulated vide letter no. W-11013/22/2009-CRSP, dated 18.06.2010 earlier. No comments were received from anyone in this regard. The Committee, therefore, confirmed the Minutes.

2. The members were informed that CCEA has approved the change in unit cost of School Toilet units from Rs. 20000 to Rs. 35000 (Rs. 38500 for Hilly and Difficult Areas). The unit cost of Anganwadi Toilet has been increased from Rs. 5000 to Rs. 8000 (Rs. 10000 for Hilly and Difficult Areas) with effect from 1-4-2010. Also CCEA has approved change in incentive for Individual household latrines (IHHL) from Rs. 2200 to 3200 (Rs. 3700 in hilly and difficult areas) w.e.f. 1-6-2011 communicated to states through vide order No.W-11013/37/2010-CRSP dated 21-6-2011 with the approval of Secretary (DWS). All district projects have been revised accordingly and uploaded on the website. The Committee approved the revisions made in the unit costs for schools and Anganwadis and the incentives amount for IHHLs to be implemented in all the 607 districts under TSC. The details of items approved for these districts are placed at Annexure II

3. The Committee reviewed the progress of TSC implementation. Director (CRSP) informed that NSSC is the highest committee for review of project proposals received under TSC. He welcomed all new members of the committee. It was intimated that against the cumulative project objectives for 607 rural districts under TSC, till date 854.12 lakh individual household toilets, 12.04 lakh school toilets, 4,05,662 Anganwadi toilets, and 23,373 community complexes have been constructed as per progress reported by the states as of February 2012.

Secretary, DWS mentioned that States should ensure that revision in toilet units in schools is only proposed for those schools which existed prior to 2006-07 as SSA was providing funds for toilets from 2007 onwards. It should, therefore, be ensured that there is no duplication of allocation of funds while proposing revision of school toilet units. It was also advised that revision in the proposal should be based on adequacy of requirement and not exactly in proportion to the strength as per mathematical calculations as the space constraint is always required to be taken into consideration.

Shri Gulshan Kag, Dy. Secretary, Ministry of Women & Child Development(MWCD), GoI informed that 5 lakh new Anganwadi Centres have been sanctioned recently. MWCD has moved an EFC for providing Rs. 5 lakh for construction of building for newly sanctioned anganwadi centres, which includes toilet also. He mentioned that for toilet, septic tank will be constructed. Secretary (DWS) mentioned that septic tank is not suitable for rural areas, so leach pit toilets should be constructed in Anganwadis. Further hence forth WCD should take care of proper sanitation facilities in all Angawadis as essential component for clean environment in and around Anganwadis. She also mentioned that WCD needs to share data on Anganwadis in Govt buildings for proper convergence between both the schemes.

Shri A.Kalmuthu mentioned that toilets in the schools are not in sufficient number. It was informed that adequacy norm for school toilets already exist in TSC guidelines based on which more than one unit could be proposed by the States after information gathering and Survey on requirements in the schools.

4. Revised proposals from Bihar

The Govt. of Bihar had submitted 38 proposals for re-revision of districts projects. NSSC examined the proposals. Principal Secretary, PHED, Govt. of Bihar informed that list of schools where toilet units are required, is provided by Education Departments of the state. Secretary (DWS) instructed that State should verify that these schools are not already covered under SSA. Regarding Anganwadi toilets, State Secretary informed that initially Anganwadi toilet figures were provided by districts. Since some new Anganwadi Centres have been opened. Now State Women and Child Development Deptt has provided revised figures of Anganwadis running in Govt. Buildings which need to be provided with sanitation facilities. Accordingly proposals have been submitted. Joint Secretary(S & A) informed that progress of the State in construction of Anganwadi toilets is very slow pulling down the overall achievement at the national level. JS(S & A) also desired that state should plan a strategy for construction of Anganwadi toilets in a defined time-frame. State Secretary

informed that now since the figures stand reconciled, more attention shall be paid to cover the anganwadis left out as of now.

The committee approved the revised proposals of Anganwadis toilets for these districts. The Committee also approved the proposals for school toilet units subject to the condition that these were in schools constructed prior to 2007. The state was requested to ensure compliance with the norms under TSC while providing for school toilets units as well as Anganwadis in Govt. buildings. The details of items approved for these districts are placed at Annexure 3.01 to 3.38. The summary of physical & financial outlays of the projects is given in the tables below:

5. Revised proposals from Gujarat

The Govt. of Gujarat had submitted 25 proposals for re-revision of districts projects. NSSC examined the proposals. TSC Co-ordinator, Govt. of Gujarat informed that school toilets unit proposed by the state are in schools not covered under SSA. He submitted a letter of State Education Deptt in this regard. He also confirmed that toilets in un-covered Anganwadis only in Government buildings are being proposed.

The committee approved the revised proposals for these districts as per above discussions. The details of items approved for these districts are placed at Annexure 4.01 to 4.25. The summary of physical & financial outlays of the projects is given in the tables below:

6. Revised proposal from Himachal Pradesh

The Govt. of Himachal Pradesh had submitted 4 proposals for revision. State representative, Govt. of Himachal informed that school toilets units have been proposed as per strength of students in schools not covered under SSA. In Sirmour district, target of Anganwadi toilets have been reduced from 1200 to 900 as the total anganwadis in govt buildings have been found to that extent only.

Approval was granted to the above on the condition that the schools proposed were those constructed prior to the year 2007. Total units for Anganwadis were approved on the condition that these were in Govt. buildings. The state was requested to verify the same for implementation of TSC.

7. Revised proposals from Mizoram

The Govt. of Mizoram had submitted 8 proposals for re-revision. In the previous NSSC meeting, it was decided that Director (CRSP) will visit Mizoram to review the requirement based on accepted norms of adequacy and non coverage under SSA and guide the state for preparation of PIP. Accordingly Director (CRSP) visited the Mizoram to guide the state on preparation of PIP and State has submitted districts proposals. TSC Coordinator, Govt. of Mizoram informed that school toilets unit proposed by the state are in schools not covered under SSA. Details of items approved for these districts are placed at Annexure 6.01-6.08. The summary of physical & financial outlays of the projects is given in the tables below:

8. Revised proposals from Rajasthan

The Govt. of Rajasthan had submitted 32 proposals for re-revision. NSSC examined the proposals. Secretary (DWS) said that State should confirm that these schools have not been covered with sanitation facilities under SSA as confirmed by other states proposing to revise their school toilet units objectives. A letter from State Govt. need to be obtained before revising the objectives as no state representative was present in the meeting. Additional Anganwadi toilets proposed by the state should be only for the anganwadis located in Govt. buildings. Details of items approved for these districts subject to the above conditions are placed at Annexure 7.01-7.32.
