Progress in Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)

During the month of June, 2021, 17,05,799 households have been provided with Functional Household Tap Water connections. An amount of Rs.1,313.87 crore has been released to States under the programme during the month.

Progress in Swachh Bharat Mission- Grameen Phase-II

During June, 2021, 94,180 Individual Household Latrines (IHHLs) and 3,407 Community Sanitary Complexes (CSC) have been constructed. An amount of Rs. 319.52 crore has been released to States under the programme during the month.

Annual Action Plan 2021-22 on JJM

Video Conference meetings with State In-charge of Rural Water Supply Department/PHED in Rajasthan and Maharashtra were held on 25th June, 2021 to review the implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission and finalization of Annual Action Plan for the Year 2021-22 respectively.
