**Subject: Monthly summary for the month of June, 2023 in respect of Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation.**

**I. Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)**

29.82 lakh households were provided with functional household tap water connections, taking the total number to 12.38 crore. An amount of Rs.497 crore was released to the States/UTs during the month.

**II. Swachh Bharat Mission – Grameen- Phase – II**

2,86,750 Individual House Latrines (IHHLs) and 2,364 Community Sanitary Complexes (CSCs) have been constructed. 32,061 more villages declared themselves ODF Plus, taking the total number to 3,58,701 out of 5,94,337 inhabited villages. An amount of Rs.155 crore was released to the States/UTs during the month.

III. Hon'ble Minister of Jal Shakti chaired a meeting on 20th June, 2023 to review the progress of ongoing works under Jal Jeevan Mission.

**IV. State Review**

Secretary, DDWS and Chief Secretary, Andhra Pradesh co-chaired a meeting to review the implementation of JJM and SBM (G) in Andhra Pradesh on 6th June, 2023 at Amravati. The meeting was attended by senior officers in person and District Collectors and their team joined through VC. Field visit was also undertaken to assess the ground situation.

Secretary, DDWS and senior officers of the Department also visited Mumbai and Chandigarh to hold joint review of the progress of JJM and SBM-G in Maharashtra and Haryana, respectively on 16th June 2023 and 30th June 2023. The meetings were attended by the Chief Secretary and senior officers in person, while District Collectors and their teams joined through VC.

Secretary, DDWS and Chief Secretary, Mizoram co-chaired a meeting to review the implementation of JJM and SBM-G with senior officers & District teams on 13th June 2023 through VC.

V. Secretary, DDWS reviewed the status of pending clearances regarding schemes under Jal Jeevan Mission from various Central & State Agencies on 12th June 2023

VI. A meeting with ACS/Principal Secretary/Secretary in-Charge of Rural Sanitation and Mission Directors of SBM-G, in all States/UTs was held on 19th June, 2023 through video conference to review the IHHLs Coverage,

Faecal Sludge Management, Financial Progress and GOBARdhan, to achieve the desired results within the timelines.

VII. Secretary, DDWS took a VC meeting with DMs/DCs/CEO-ZPs of 50 Bottom districts under SBM(G) on 20th June, 2023 to expedite implementation of SBM(G).

**VIII. Monthly newsletter**

The monthly newsletter of SBM-G viz. "Swachhata Samachar" was issued for the month of June, 2023. It will apprise the States about various campaigns being organised under SBM-G. It also solicits States/UTs' to share success stories on Solid and Liquid Waste Management.
