Subject: Monthly summary for the month of May, 2021 in respect of Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation.

Progress in Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)

During the month of May, 2021, 7,16,219 households have been provided with Functional Household Tap water connections. An amount of Rs.7,577.65 crore has been released to States under the programme during the month. After Goa, Telangana and Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Union Territory of Puducherry has become 'Har Ghar Jal' UT with every rural household getting water tap connection during the month.

Progress in Swachh Bharat Mission- Grameen Phase-II

During May, 2021, 70,888 Individual Household Latrines (IHHLs) and 2,175 Community Sanitary Complexes (CSC) have been constructed. An amount of Rs. 154.68 crore has been released to States under the programme during the month.

Annual Action Plan 2021-22 on JJM

Video Conference meetings with State/UT In-charge of Rural Water Supply Department/PHED in Kerala, A & N Islands and Uttarakhand were held on 5th, 7th & 28th May, 2021, respectively, for finalization of the Annual Action Plan (AIPs) 2021-22 of the Jal Jeevan Mission under the chairmanship of Secretary, DDWS. Several review meetings were also held with many of the States/ UTs.

Annual Implementation Plans (AIPs) on SBM-G, 2021-22

Meetings of Plan Appraisal Committee to discuss the Annual Implementation Plans (AIPs) 2021-22 were held with the 17 States individually, namely, Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Mizoram, Puducherry, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and West Bengal, from 4th May, 2021 to 20th May, 2021 virtually through VC. The AIP of each State was discussed in detail and suggestions/observations were intimated to the States for improvement.

2nd meeting of National Scheme Sanctioning Committee (NSSC) of Phase-II of SBM(G) was held on 27th May, 2021 under the chairmanship of Secretary, DDWS through video conferencing to consider the AIPs of the States/UTs under SBM(G) for 2021-22 for approval. The AIPs of all the States/UTs were discussed and approved.

Sarpanch Samvad

Hon'ble Minister of Jal Shakti chaired the "Sarpanch Samvad" held on 28th May, 2021. 12 Sarpanches from States of Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Jammu & Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, and Telangana participated in the Samvad. Hon'ble Minister interacted with the Sarpanches. Discussions were held mainly on success stories in their villages in the field of sanitation including SLWM, ODF Sustainability, issues regarding implementation of ODF Plus, effective utilization of 15th Finance Commission funds, and the initiatives undertaken related to Covid pandemic.

An interaction with PRIs was earlier held on 07.05.2021 through Video Conferencing. Five Sarpanches from the States of Odisha, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh participated in that Samvad.
