
2. In this regard, Government of Tamil Nadu has informed that they have also planned passing of resolutions in the Gram Sabha in each Gram Panchayat on the following:

- (ii) Fine for littering in public places
- (iii) Banning use of Single Use Plastics (SUPs)
- (iv) Sustaining cleanliness even after the campaign
