Sir,

As you are aware, National Drinking Water Security Pilot Projects are being implemented in 15 over-exploited blocks in 11 States of India, including your State in selected block (Dhuri).

It was noted that the Support Organisation earlier contracted for the works to be done in Pilot Projects, did not reflect satisfactory progress. As a result, the State selected another Support organisation through a fresh tender process, and a new SO has been contracted and is in place now.

However, the previous SO, (Shamshad Ali Khan Support Organisation), is continuously raising queries to this Ministry for the fund-related discrepancies by the State Government, against the work completed by them.

Since the contract was terminated, and a new SO was appointed under the State Government, for the Pilot Projects; the matter should have been resolved at the State level itself.

However, the State has not responded to them in this regard, or there is some gap in communication, resulting in an undesired escalation to this Ministry.

Hence, this matter needs immediate intervention of the State and the aforesaid SO.

It is, therefore, requested that a meeting may please be called at your level for sorting-out the issue once for all.

The proceeding of the meeting may also be sent to this Ministry.






