Subject: Ensuring provision of toilets in all Government Schools in rural India through strengthening convergence of SSHE component of NBA with SSA Department of School Education and Literacy,(DSEL).

Sir,

It has been indicated by Department of School Education and Literacy,(DSEL) Ministry of Human Resource Development that as per the District Information System for Education (DISE) 2010-11, a total of 424340 schools did not have boys toilets/common toilets and 78,324 elementary schools were without drinking water. The status of drinking water and sanitation in Government Schools in rural India as per the DISE 2010-11 is enclosed at Annexure I.


2. As per the online Monitoring System of the MDWS, the total No. of School Toilet blocks constructed so far is 12,36,054 as against project objectives of 13,75,234 with a balance objective of 139180. The State wise figures are at annexure II.

3. As per the convergence mechanism set up with SSA component of DSEL, only those schools prior to 2007 which were part of the baseline survey would be covered under NBA. Remaining schools (post 2007) would be covered under SSA.

4. The States are requested to reconcile the figures with reference to the enclosed Annexures and intimate to this Ministry the targets and achievements under NBA as to complete project objectives set for School toilets under NBA by March 2013.

5. It is also suggested that suitable instructions may be issued to the officials implementing NBA for strengthening convergence with SSA for ensuring that all schools are covered with toilets.
